The proposed by-law changes were sent out to membership prior to this meeting. There were no responses or concerns solicited to the proposed changes. Christy made a motion to vote to accept changes to Bylaws, Joseli seconded. No opposed. The new by-law changes are as follows:

"The executive committee shall consist of the officers, chairpersons of standing committees and the immediate Past Chair. Members shall elect from their voting membership Chair, Vice-Chair, Treasurer, Secretary and committee chairs to serve for a two-year term., beginning in July of even number of years and ending in June. Candidates receiving the highest number of votes of the voting members present shall be deemed elected. In the event of a vacancy of any officer, the voting membership will be given a month's notice and take a new vote. The officers may serve a maximum of two consecutive two-year terms.

Section 7.3 Membership Committee

Members of the Membership committee shall be appointed by the executive committee to serve for a specified period of time. The committee shall: (a) nominate officers and candidates for membership on the executive committee; (b) recommend the criteria for the selection of new members; (c) provide orientation to new members; (d) analyze regularly the attendance of members; (e) consult with those who are not attending regularly or fail to attend the minimum number of committee meetings; (f) recommend to the officers action regarding inactive members; (g) recommend to general membership the schedule of meeting dates. At least four weeks prior to voting, the committee shall notify the membership of the names of the persons nominated, with a brief profile describing the qualifications of each proposed nominee.""""
